

TAG Farnborough Airport

NATS

We provide Air Traffic Control (ATC) services at 14 UK airports, including Farnborough. At Farnborough, we provide tower, approach and LARS services.

TOWER

This is an ATC service provided in and around the airport. The controllers will look out of the tower windows, as well as at the ATC equipment, to help aircraft taxi, take-off and land.

APPROACH

This is a radar-based control service located in the lower part of the tower. Incoming aircraft are managed from approximately 40 miles away from the aerodrome, generally under 10,000ft. The aircraft are transferred to the tower controller when the aircraft are approximately 4-8 miles from the aerodrome.

LARS

LARS - Lower Airspace Radar Service for aircraft flying outside controlled airspace or wishing to transit our controlled airspace.

THE OPERATION: 2015

The current tower was opened in 2002. NATS has been providing an ATC service at Farnborough since 2003. It does not report on passenger numbers.
