NATS

We provide Air Traffic Control (ATC) services at 14 UK airports, including London Luton Airport. At London Luton Airport, we provide tower and engineering services.

TOWER

The controllers look out of the control tower windows and use other ATC equipment, including ground and airborne surveillance to help aircraft taxi, take-off and land.

ENGINEERING

An engineering team, based at the airport, are responsible for maintaining air traffic control services, such as radar and the Instrument Landing System (ILS). As well as monitoring things the engineering team are responsible for carrying out preventative and corrective maintenance on a daily basis.

THE OPERATION: 2015

The tower was opened in 1995. NATS has been providing an ATC service at Luton since 2000.
